Minimal Access Surgery (MAS)

Minimal Access Surgery, also called keyhole surgery or pinhole surgery, is a modern surgical technique in which surgery is performed through skin or anatomical openings instead of longer conventional incisions as needed in traditional surgical procedures. By using high end equipments, this surgical procedure translates into faster recovery, lesser post-operative pain and minimal post-surgical complications.



In a MAS procedure, the surgeon inserts a fiber optic tube (the laparoscope) attached with high definition camera and thin long-reaching surgical instruments through the small incisions (usually 0.5 – 1.5 cm) into a body cavity. The surgeon examines and operates with the aid of video on the monitor. This procedure helps in better viewing of the surgical area and in ensuring minimal tissue damage, making the surgery safer and less painful for the patient.

Benefits of MAS

MAS offers many advantages to the patient, including:

- Faster recovery and resumption of activities of daily life
- Minimal tissue damage, hence less pain
- Shorter hospital stay
- Minimal post-operative infections
- Smaller incisions and less scarring
- Minimal incidence of wound infections
- Quicker & accurate diagnosis

At Beams Hospitals, MAS procedures are performed in Gynaecology, General Surgery, Urology and Arthroscopy.

Gynaecology

- Laparoscopic Hysterectomy (removal of uterus laparoscopically)
- Laparoscopic Myomectomy (removal of fibroids laparoscopically)

- Laparoscopy for Infertility (diagnosis and management of infertility related problems laparoscopically)
- Laparoscopy for Ovarian Cysts (removal of cysts in ovaries laparoscopically)
- Hysteroscopic Surgery (inspection of uterine cavity by endoscopy with access through normal birth passage)
- Laparoscopy for Urinary Incontinence
- Laparoscopy for Malignancy (cancer)

- Cholecystectomy (removal of gall bladder)
- Appendicectomy (removal of appendix)
- Splenectomy (removal of spleen for blood related disorder)
- Laparoscopic Fundoplication (surgery to prevent gastroesophageal reflux)
- Laparoscopic Colectomy (removal of large intestine for cancer or other diseases)
- Laparoscopic Bariatric Procedures (for weight reduction)
- Thoracoscopic Sympathectomy (for reducing excessive sweating of palm and sole)

Urology

- Laparoscopic Nephrectomy (removal of kidney laparoscopically)
- Laparoscopic Pyeloplasty (removal of kidney obstruction laparoscopically)
- Percutaneous Nephrolithotomy (PCNL - removal of renal stones)
- Ureteroscopy (removal of ureteral stone endoscopically)
- Visual Internal Urethrotomy (VIU - uretric stricture)
- Transurethral Resection of the Prostate (TURP - enlarged prostate)

Arthroscopy

Knee

- Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) Reconstruction (repair or reconstruction of ligament)
- Meniscectomy (repair or removal of cartilage)

Wrist

- Carpel Tunnel Syndrome

Shoulder

- Rotator Cuff Repair (trimming of shoulder bone)
- Pain Relief Surgery for Shoulder
- Repair of Muscles
- Stabilisation of Dislocated Shoulder
